



# How can we help our students to prepare?

Share and discuss the differences between education and work

Encourage students to talk to people they know in different jobs about what it's like

Look for 'day in the life' employer websites or social media Run Q & A sessions with former students who are now working

Share the benefits
of proactive
research on
employers, sectors
and industries

Make sure students know and take advantage of all the support available

Encourage students to look at all the UCAS resources available Support students to undertake work experience or work shadowing Reach out to school community to find mentors from different sectors Encourage students to become familiar with different relevant tech and software

Run sessions on 'soft skills' employers may expect
