



Employer-Led


Apprenticeships are developed and delivered by employers, ensuring you gain relevant skills for the workplace.

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Apprenticeship Levels and Qualifications Explained




Entry-level apprenticeships suitable for those with GCSEs or equivalent qualifications.

Level 3

Intermediate apprenticeships requiring A-Levels or equivalent, leading to a higher national diploma.

Level 4 and Above

Advanced apprenticeships offering higher qualifications, including degrees, and specialized skills.





Financing Your Apprenticeship: Costs and Funding

Employer Contribution	Most employers contribute to the cost of apprenticeship training.
Government Funding	The government provides funding for eligible apprenticeships through various schemes.
Apprenticeship Levy	Larger companies pay a levy, which can be used to fund apprenticeships within their organization or shared with other businesses.

QUALIFICATIONS NOT INCLUDED


Often jobs require additional qualifications besides a degree to work in that industry.

Carefully review the application requirements and submit a compelling application that showcases your skills and enthusiasm.

Interview

Prepare for your interview by researching the company and practising your answers to common interview questions.

Communicate effectively with your employer, colleagues, and mentors.




Teamwork and Collaboration
